

Pathways to Obtain an HIV Test

PATHWAY A: MD TESTING

Most often used for “*Diagnostic Testing*” (i.e. patient exhibiting signs or symptoms that may be from HIV infection)

PATHWAY B: EIP

Most often used for patient at risk for exposure to HIV, but not exhibiting signs or symptoms suggesting HIV infection

PATHWAY C: POST-EXPOSURE

For situations where the test is being ordered to inform post-exposure prophylaxis decisions
