



- Exclusion Criteria**
- Unstable vitals
 - Ongoing seizures
 - Atypical seizures, per neuro consult
 - < 2 hrs since last seizure
 - > 1 seizure in ED after receiving AED
 - Need for continuous EEG
 - Clinical suspicion of meningitis
 - New stroke
 - Concern for ETOH withdrawal
 - Seizure secondary to toxic exposure
 - Pregnancy
 - New finding on head CT
 - Focal neurologic finding
 - Dialysis/ESRD patient
 - Concerning EKG finding
 - Social concerns making discharge within 24 hrs unlikely

- Antiepileptics that can be quantified:**
- Valproic acid
 - Phentoin
 - Carbamazepine
 - Lamotrigine
 - Lacosimide
 - Topiramate
 - Oxcarbazepine
