
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## **Exclusion Criteria**

- Unstable vitals
- · Ongoing seizures
- · Atypical seizures, per neuro consult
- < 2 hrs since last seizure</li>
- · > 1 seizure in ED after receiving AED
- · Need for continuous EEG
- · Clinical suspicion of meningitis
- · Concern for EtOH withdrawal
- · Seizure secondary to toxic exposure
- Pregnancy · New finding on head CT
- · Focal neurologic finding
- · Dialysis/ESRD patient
- · Concerning EKG finding
- · Social concerns making discharge within 24 hrs unlikely

## Antileptics that can be quantified:

- · Valproic acid
- · Phentoin
- Carbamazepine
- Lamotrigine
- · Lacosimide
- Topiramate
- Oxcarbazepine
